Please make sure your emergency contact knows a history of any medical problems that you may have experienced with your pet. For example, if your pet sometimes limps after playing ball, gets diarrhea easily, or occasionally is lethargic and cranky, it would be helpful to have that history available. Then, if your pet exhibits these same behaviors when in our care, your contact person will know this is normal for your pet.

In the event that your pet does require medical attention, know that we will do everything possible to contact you. However, should you not be available, please take the time to answer the questions below, so that we may see that your wishes are met.

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Notice

Notice

The boarding of animals is subject to Article 3.2 (3.2-6518 Et. Seq.) of Chapter 65 of Title 3.2.

If your animal becomes ill or injured while in the custody of the boarding establishment or groomer, the boarding establishment or groomer shall provide the animal with emergency veterinary treatment for the illness or injury.

The consumer shall bear the reasonable and necessary costs of emergency veterinary treatment for any illness or injury occurring while the animal is in the custody of the boarding establishment or groomer. The boarding establishment or groomer shall pay for veterinary treatment of any injury that the animal sustains while at the establishment or under the care or custody of a groomer if the injury resulted from the establishment's or groomer's failure, whether accidental or intentional, to provide the care required by Sec. 3.2-6503, or if the injury is a result of the actions of the boarding establishment or groomer. Boarding establishments and groomers shall not be required to bear the cost of veterinary treatment for injuries resulting from the animal's self-mutilation.

Consumer shall bear the reasonable and necessary costs of veterinary treatment for any injury resulting from dog play and/or dog altercations, provided boarding facility or groomer took all necessary precautions to avoid such an interaction. Precautions include monitoring play groups, properly testing dog behavior, grouping dogs appropriately based on size and temperament.
